"Extreme Makeover: Home Edition" build in Geneva to donate surplus materials to Habitat for Humanity build in local community

Mahoney Design and Build Inc, builder of the "Extreme Makeover: Home Edition" home in Geneva, New York, will donate surplus materials from the build to Habitat for Humanity of Ontario County for their upcoming projects. Materials include siding, tools, sheetrock, and many other items. They are also encouraging volunteers who worked on the project or who were not selected for the project to donate their time to the Habitat build as well.

Habitat for Humanity of Ontario County will have a groundbreaking ceremony on Sunday, August 24, as they begin work on their 11th house in the county and third in the city of Geneva. Jessica Parmalee and her three children, Erica, Jordan, and Jovani are the family selected to partner with Habitat in the building of the house to become their very own home.

Jessica and family were selected, from among several qualifying families, to be homeowners of the first of several houses to be built by Habitat with partnering families, on property purchased from the city on Hawkins and Sweeney avenues. Vacant for many years, the property will yield a total of seven lots for Habitat homes and families.

The groundbreaking ceremony will begin at 2 p.m. and will include several area clergy, the city mayor, and Habitat board members, as well as the Parmalee family. Refresh-

ments will be available following the ceremony, which will include music, prayer, messages and shoveling.

Foundation work is proceeding this week in preparation for "Blitz Week" September 6 through the 13, when the house will be raised and enclosed. Completion will take place weekends, after that.

The community is invited and welcome to attend, in support of Habitat's partnership efforts with the city, volunteers, local contractors and suppliers, local churches and organizations to provide another advance toward worldwide elimination of substandard housing.
